An Analysis of Texas Higher Education Enrollment Trends: Examining the Goals of Strategic Enrollment Management and Leadership

ABSTRACT

This study focuses on two institutions in the state of Texas, one which has experienced a decline in student enrollment, and the other which has experienced an increase, and analyzes their enrollment management practices. METHOD
