ARE GUN FREE ZONES SAFE?

ABSTRACT

A gun free zone may be an area as small as a school yard or as large as a country where only the police and military have access to firearms and maintain a superior force. Events during the past several decades have raised questions on the safety of individuals in what has been classified as "Gun Free Zones." These zones are intended to provide a safe environment for individuals without the possibility of firearms being brought into the area and displayed, discharged or used for any purpose.
