E-PORTFOLIOS: FROM CONCEPT TO COMPLETION

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Abstract

A student portfolio is a purposeful collection of student work that tells the story of student's personal self and a student's achievement or growth. Changes in technology have allowed traditional media to be transformed to e-portfolios, which store electronic documents and multimedia files in a structured format that can be securely shared. E-Portfolio systems are receiving widespread acceptance; however, these systems have limitations, costs, and privacy concerns. This paper shows the results of a study that examines student perceptions regarding potential implementation of e-portfolio systems and then discusses the implications of the study's findings for system adoption.
