

A Decade of Management International Review Research: A Content Analysis
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International business research has grown in size and scope over recent decades and the Management International Review (MIR) is recognized as one of the top journals of the field. Using content analysis, the researcher analyzed 304 articles published in MIR during the ten year period from 2003-2012 to identify the countries most often researched as well as the location of authors publishing in MIR. The results show that the countries most often researched during the past ten years of publication were China, the United States, Japan, Germany, Taiwan, the United Kingdom and Russia. Article authors most often came from institutions in the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, Germany, and China, among others. The study identifies gaps in the literature and the findings of the study have implications for the focus of future country research, particularly regarding emerging markets.
