Abstract

The curriculum for bachelor's degrees varies across institutions that offer certification in business education. One method of obtaining teacher certification in Texas is to earn a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Every future teacher must select an academic major of interest and complete the educator preparation courses. This research will examine the curricula among universities in the state of Texas offering baccalaureate degrees that qualify for certification in the area of business education. Identification of specific courses and the relation of those courses to the business educator standards will be reviewed. A comparison of the required courses and how they link to the standards will be examined to determine consistency and differences in the designated degrees.
